This third time event will be held at Spring Hill on Thurlga Station in the beautiful pristine Gawler Ranges, 95 kms north of Kimba on Eyre Peninsula.

After the weekend is over stay a little longer and explore more of the magnificent, relatively untouched Gawler Ranges. Site of our newest National Park, these ancient volcanic ranges are home to over 140 species of birds, including the emu and wedge tailed eagle. Also common are red and western grey kangaroos and rock wallabies. Before digressing from the main roads or camping, station owner's permission should be sought.

No pets allowed to avoid disturbance to livestock and native fauna.

ACCOMMODATION

Camping under the stars, so bring your own swag, tent, trailer or van. No powered sites. No generators allowed.

Kimba is located 4 ½ hours west of Adelaide, South Australia on the Eyre Highway between Port Augusta and Ceduna.
